


Patriots Day 2019 is scheduled for Monday, April 15th. Patriots Day is a civic holiday, a time for Americans to remember the anniversary of the Battles of Lexington and Concord. These battles are considered the very first battles of the American Revolutionary War against Great Britain. Patriots' Day is a state holiday in Massachusetts and Maine, where state, county, and municipal offices are closed. However, Patriots' Day is not a federal public holiday and federal offices are open. Many schools are closed for the spring break.



APRIL 26, 2019

For centuries, communities spanning the globe have found various ways to honor nature and the environment. However, the appreciation of trees and forests in modern times can be largely attributed to Arbor Day—which literally translates to “tree” day from the Latin origin of the word arbor—a holiday that celebrates the planting, upkeep and preservation of trees. The origins of Arbor Day dates back to the early 1870s. It wasn't until 1970, however, that Arbor Day became recognized nationwide. Although some states celebrate Arbor Day at different times of year to ensure that the trees are in the best environment to thrive, the national observance falls on the last Friday in April.



WEIRD HISTORY STUFF


These are facts of events that happened in the past that have caused us to do certain things without even knowing why we do them. There are also some random things about the history of certain people. (like you couldn't figure that out)
